TCX was formed in 2007 and currently runs a global emerging market swaps portfolio of ca. USD 5 billion, supported by a capital base of ca. USD 1.2 billion.

Its capital is provided by 20 leading development finance institutions and microfinance investors (including IFC, EBRD, KfW, FMO, AFD/Proparco, DBSA and others).
